† CALL TO CONFESSION

Confession is a hallmark of the Reformed tradition. We believe that it is important to begin worship by confessing the ways we've fallen short of God's intention for us.

Each confession is concluded by the **Assurance of Pardon**. A liturgical reminder that no sin is so powerful as to keep us from the love of God.

During the **Passing of the Peace** you're invited to greet one another by saying "The peace of Christ be with you."

The **Prayer of Illumination** is a prayer asking God to shed light on the meaning of scripture, essentially requesting the Holy Spirit to open one's mind and heart to understand the deeper truths within the Bible.

PENTECOST PARAMENTS

On the day of Pentecost "divided tongues, as of fire" appeared among the disciples, and all were filled with the Holy Spirit. The bold reds of these paraments evoke this powerful image from Acts 2. The lectern parament and the pastor's stole depict a dove, reminding us of that scene in the Gospels in which the Holy Spirit descends on the baptized Jesus "like a dove". Because of its association with the gift of the Spirit at baptism, the Pentecost paraments are also used for celebrations of ordination and installation.
